It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free **and held harmless** from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. It is further understood that Southeastern LSC, City of Troy and Troy Torpedoes Swim Team shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries, infection or exposure by anyone during the conduct of the event.

FACILITIES: Outdoor 8-lane, 25 yard pool with water depths at the start end of 6 feet, and at the turn end 4 feet. Competition will use 6 lanes and our indoor pool will serve as our warm-up/cool-down lane with 4 lanes.

We reserve the right to combine heats, events, and/or sessions at the discretion of the meet director in order to run the most efficient meet. Meet management may opt to use fly-over starts at this competition. Non-turbulent lane lines and fully automatic Colorado electronic timing system and scoreboard with lane/time/place/event/heat display. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Entry to the warm down lanes will open in the indoor pool at all times. Coaches are asked to help direct their swimmers to comply with this requirement.

The Meet Director and Referee reserve the right to alter the course(s) if deemed necessary.

RULES: USA Swimming rules will govern the meet, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"). All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

SAFETY: In the interest of safety and accident prevention, spectators, coaches and swimmers are asked to observe all posted pool rules and to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Only meet officials, volunteers, coaches, and swimmers will be allowed on the pool deck. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Teams are asked not to bring more than 2 coaches.

Please be advised that the Troy area is subject to severe weather and therefore delays during the meet when thunderstorms or lightning are in the vicinity should be anticipated. The Troy Parks and Recreation's aquatic facility has strict rules prohibiting swimming while thunder and lightning storms are in the area. The Troy Parks and Recreation Aquatic Staff will be the ones to determine if lightning is within the area and will halt the swim meet and we will have to wait until we get the all clear.

MEDICAL: Medical services will not be available on site. Certified lifeguards will be onsite and will contact medical professionals if medical issues arise.

ELIGIBILITY: All participants must be USA Swimming registered athletes. Entries will not be accepted without current registration numbers. NO on-deck USA Swimming registration will be allowed. Coaches and officials must present evidence of certification as required by Southeastern Swimming. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine his or her age for the entire meet.

DISABILITIES: Swimmers with disabilities are welcome and highly encouraged. Coaches with disabled swimmers are requested to complete the attached Information Form for Disabled Swimmers and return it with the entries in order to efficiently make swimmer accommodations prior to the start of the meet.

WARM UP: Warm-ups will begin at 8:00am Saturday Morning with the competition beginning at 9:00am. The Meet Director will post the warm-up assignments prior to the start of the meet warm-up. Southeastern Swimming Meet Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

ENTRIES: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in preforming a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Teams who have HYTEK's Meet/Team Manager should submit their entries via e-mail. Entry forms must be completely filled out including the swimmers' best times for yards. Please provide a written copy of entries with the event numbers and event description in published event order for verification purposes. Teams without "Team Manager" are encouraged to use Hytek's Team Manager Lite which is available free for download direct from Hytek via the following website: http://www.hy-tekltd.com/downloads.html

ENTRY FEES: Please make checks payable to: Troy Torpedoes Swim Team. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

• Individual: \$5.00 per event (\$7.00 late entry)

• Relay: \$10.00 per relay (\$12.00 late entry)

• Facility surcharge: \$20.00 per athlete

ENTRY LIMIT: Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events and 1 relay events on Saturday

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries may be allowed at the discretion of meet management. Deck entries may be allowed if: (1) The swimmer is not already entered in the maximum allowable events for the day; (2) The requested event is not a substitute for another event; (3) There is an empty lane in the requested event; and (4) Deck Entry (\$7.00) and applicable meet fees must be paid at time of entry. No new heats will be added. Deck entries must be requested at least 30 minutes before the start of the session in which the deck entry is made.

ENTRY ERRORS: If due to Troy Torpedoes error, the swimmer will be deck entered into an open lane of the heat nearest his/her entry time or in a new heat. The entire event will not be reseeded.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entry forms, printouts, release/recap sheet and entry fees including surcharges must be received by the Meet Director on or before August 29, 2024, subject to entry limits

SEEDING: All events are timed finals and will be seeded according to all applicable USA Swimming rules. Seed times will be times entered on the entry form. Entries with no time (NT) will be seeded by random draw. Notification of scratches will be appreciated in case lanes are needed for late entries. We reserve the right to limit any event as necessary due to the session limitations. Teams will be notified if any events have been limited as stated above. The courses, sessions, and events will be split or combined at the discretion of the meet referee in the interest of running the most efficient meet.

SCRATCHES: All scratches should be submitted to the Clerk of Course as soon as possible to provide lanes for possible late entries.

AWARDS: Meet will be swum and scored by age bracket and gender. High point awards will be given to the top 8 finishers in 8U, 9-10, and 11-12 age, 13-14 & 15&U groups for each gender. Awards will be given to coaches after the swim meet or can be mailed to the team

SCORING: Points for first through eighth places in Individual events will be awarded as follows: 9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

COACHES MEETING: A coaches meeting will be held prior to the beginning of the swim meet Saturday AM

HOSPITALITY: There will be a hospitality table available with breakfast & lunch for coaches and officials only.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be sold at this meet as well as vending machines in the recreation center are available for use.
